

Park Hills Board Meeting Nov.11, 2007

Members present: Della Rucker, Garrett levy, Jay Geiser, Larry Wharton, Phil Schneider

Meeting was called to order at 7:04 P.M.

Minutes from the Oct. 24 meeting were unanimously approved

The treasurer's report dated Oct.31 were also unanimously approved.

Garrett said that the trail needed one more layer of gravel that should hold up for five years. He and Rhett have begun applying this and hoped to be finished before winter.

Bids for the lighting repairs were discussed. They ranged from \$4800 to \$7500, depending on whether we wanted to "patch" or do a complete redo. The Board agreed to do the "complete" redo. This requires the contractor to dig 18 inches down for the new PVC pipe. The Board gave Jay Geiser the approval to increase the bid if the contractor could provide vandal proof fixtures for the dip, similar to the ones used at the gazebo.

Jay will contact Ground Masters and have them winterize the sprinklers as well as ensure that they will plant and maintain the two turnaround areas on Vineyard and Normandy in 2008.

Della is going to contact the people who volunteered to update the Design Guide to see if they will complete this project.

The annual meeting was set for Feb.27 at the Recreation Center. Unanimous agreement was reached to maintain the dues at \$200.
